



TREATMENT OF PRECONSTRUCTION LUMBER AND LOGS

General information: Timbertreat® 15WT insecticide can be diluted with water or suitable base oil. To prepare the mixture, dilute Timbertreat® 15WT as shown in the following dilution chart:

Directions for Application

To protect unseasoned or seasoned lumber and logs from wood destroying insects, such as termites, carpenter ants and beetles (ambrosia, powder-post, old house borers and others), totally treat the wood with up to 1.0% dilution of chlorpyrifos. This dilution can be applied by spraying, brushing, dipping, or pressure treatment. Monitoring of the treating mixture may be necessary to insure that the desired level of chlorpyrifos is maintained. Wear protective clothing such as long sleeved shirt, long legged pants, hat, rubber gloves and footwear impervious to aromatic solvents, i.e. neoprene or nitrile butadiene rubber, during preparation of solution, treatment, and when handling freshly treated wet wood. Following treatment, wood can be safely handled when dry.

1. Dip Treatment: Rates of 0.5% to 1.0% are recommended for dip treatments to insure adequate retentions. The wood should be totally submersed in the dilution until thoroughly wet and then allowed to dry in a suitable location. Dipping solutions to which Timbertreat® 15WT has been added should be agitated before use if left unused for long periods of time. Sediment, debris, and other deposits should be periodically cleaned from tank.

2. Pressure Treatment: Rates of 0.25% to 0.5% are recommended for adequate penetration and retention. After the pressure is released and the system drained, the wood should be placed in a suitable location for drying.

3. Spray Treatment or Brush Treatment: Rates of 0.5% to 1.0% are recommended for spray and brush treatments. The wood, including back and ends, should be sprayed or brushed thoroughly with the treatment mixture.
