The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the **Propiconazole RED** and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statement of Formulation (CSF) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

- Basic CSF, dated January 31, 2014

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed along with copies of the acute toxicity and product chemistry reviews completed for the subject product. GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS:

FOR INDUSTRIAL USE ONLY

CONSULT MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET BEFORE USING

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. This preservative is recognized as effective for above ground use and not recommended for ground contact. Woodlife® 3 is intended for use on new lumber, plywood, particleboard, waterboard, millwork and similar type of wood products.

This clear oil solution has been developed for the protection of wood against fungus growths which cause rot and stain. It also contains water repellents to aid in control of shrinking, swelling, and checking, grain raising and warping.

For best results, this product must be applied so as to effect maximum penetration into wood and heavy absorption especially at joints and wherever end grain exists. A three minute immersion period is recommended for millwork. For other open tank treatments, complete immersion of the wood in the solution is generally recommended for five minutes per inch of thickness. For the control of dimensional changes, shrinkage and swelling, the treatment of the end grain is most important since the moisture pickup there is a hundred to a thousand times greater than at the flat or edge grain surface for many species of wood.

Where open tank treating is impractical, two heavy brush applicators of this product must be applied, cutting out and removing all unsound wood two feet beyond any visible evidence of decay. All wood must be normally dry and the framing or cutting completed before application of this product.

Estimated Coverage: 5 To 10 gallons per thousand board feet for open tank treatment. 200 Square Feet per gallon for brush application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a closed, properly labeled container in a cool place. If static generating conditions exist, provide necessary grounding and bonding. Keep containers closed when not in use.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available.
