

- Spray Applications: Mix one gallon of Woodtreat® XP Sapstain Control Product to 15-50 gallons of water.
- Immersion applications: Mix one gallon of Woodtreat® XP Sapstain Control Product to 50-300 gallons of water.

For best results, apply Woodtreat® XP Sapstain Control Product to recently felled and freshly sawn or peeled wood ensuring total coverage. Allow treated wood to drain in a contained area before storage, and ensure that freshly treated wood is not allowed to remain unprotected in heavy rains.
