Use Copper Treat® 9.0 to control all types of fungal decay of wood products- brown, white, and soft rot, and wood eating insects including termites. Copper Treat 9.0 should be used to treat any wood product that will be exposed to conditions favorable to rot, decay, or insect attack both above ground and in ground, or in water. Types of products include lumber, timbers, landscape ties, fence posts, building and utility poles and freshwater and marine piling, sea walls, decking, and wood shingles.

Tank mix Copper Treat @ 9.0 with quaternary ammonium compounds approved for wood treatment. Contact Kop-Coat, Inc for recommendations and further information.

A 3% solution can be used to field coat the cut ends of pressure-treated wood by brush- on application.

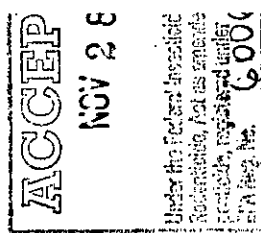

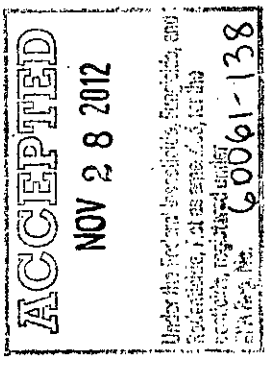
