The Amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, in which you provide final printed labels, is being accepted as a minor label amendment (**not as final printed labels**), with the following comments.

1. The requirement to submit one copy of the final printed label, as per the Registration Notification dated 1/29/97, is still unfulfilled. The final printed label must **exactly** match the stamped label in the Registration Notification and your submitted label does not. Therefore, you must submit a true final printed label **before any new amendments will be considered** for this product. Also note that the Agency does not stamp final printed labels as per PR Notice 82-2. We understand that in the future, you expect to submit additional revised label amendments for this product which will conform to anticipated changes required by the Aliphatic Alcohol RED.
2. We are approving the following minor changes in the revised labels you provided:
 - A. Addition of a graphic picture showing how to pull out each towelette.
 - B. Minor changes in the wording and location of the bacterial kill claims. The location is moved from the front panel to the side panel.
 - C. Making minor changes to the Statement of Practical Treatment.
 - D. Making minor changes to the "Use Directions".

A stamped copy of the accepted amended label is attached for your files.
