APPLICATION OF CHIP SHOT II

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in interior plantscapes, ornamental gardens or parks, or on golf course or lawns and grounds.

CHIP SHOT II is a selective pre-emergence herbicide for control of grassy weeds in all varieties and hybrids of Bermudagrass and Bluegrass. Not for use on home lawns. When applied according to directions this product will not harm most nearby ornamental trees and shrubs. Apply to turf prior to weed seed germination since established weeds will not be controlled. Apply only to healthy established turf grass lawns. Rake turf area free of leaves, mowing if necessary so that the herbicide reaches the soil surface. Measure area to be treated and uniformly apply the required amount. Do not apply to wet turf. If rain is not expected shortly after application, irrigate turf to wash herbicide into the soil surface for maximum weed control. Germination of overseeded grasses may be reduced up to 50% if seeded within 4 months of a spring application.

**WHEN, WHERE
AND HOW TO APPLY**

FOR CRABGRASS, GOOSEGRASS AND CROWFOOT CONTROL

For pre-emergent control of these weedy grasses apply 200 lbs. / acre or to turf before weed seeds germinate. Later applications may not be effective and are not recommended unless spring treatments have been delayed due to weather conditions and a pre-emergence herbicide will be required in the turf maintenance program. Apply to dry foliage only. Complete all aerifying/verticutting etc. operations before applying.

CHIP SHOT II contains Ureaform as the base fertilizer. It is a slow release, non-burning, non-leaching, odorless, and pathogen free source of nitrogen. When applied at 200 lbs. per acre it will supply the majority of total "N" nitrogen required for optimum growth of Bermudagrass and Bluegrass. Soil tests may indicate the requirement for additional nutrients during the season. Applied as needed.

RESEEDING TREATED AREAS

Delay spot reseeding at least 4 months after treatment.

SPREADER SETTINGS

The following spreader settings are for use with new equipment. Spreaders may need calibrating since proper application is based on the spreader's condition with regard to age and use, application speed and the unevenness of the terrain

Use the Rate Charts for other Spreaders and set to apply Blue Chip or Nitroform at 200 lbs./acre

IMPORTANT

Use only on Bermudagrass and Bluegrass since other grasses may not be tolerant to this herbicide. Do not use on newly sprigged areas of Bermuda or Bluegrass until turf is established and is "filling in" or on newly seeded Bermuda or Bluegrass areas until after second cutting. Use only at the rate of 200 lbs. per acre. Do not apply to Bermuda grass which has been overseeded with winter grasses (such as annual ryegrass) since thinning will occur. Do not use on greens or tees because of special cultural requirements.
