Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

2. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

3. Under the Precautionary Statements, " STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" revise the Disposal Statement to read "Empty the container by squeezing the applicator and applying the product into the cracks and crevices of wall or according to the directions for use. Securely wrap the original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."
4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling to the Agency before you release this product for shipment.
5. Enclosed is a copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments." This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for control reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

### WHERE & HOW TO USE

Use in Homes and other areas as listed  
May be used in Food Storage Areas, Processing &  
Serving Areas, in Bath Rooms, Sleeping Rooms,  
Closets, and Food Disposal Areas. Do not place bait  
in areas accessible to children or pets. Do not use  
on Marble surfaces. Always replace cap on tube  
after use.

This product is a ready to use Bait-Gel. Apply by  
squeezing through the applicator tip. Apply  
liberally to cracks & crevices; under & behind  
refrigerators, stoves, sinks, dishwashers, washing  
machines, dryers and tubs; into cracks & crevices  
around drains, water pipes and electrical conduits;  
along baseboards, corners of cabinets, cupboards &  
closets. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen &  
bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and chests of  
drawers. Apply a "strip" of Bait-Gel along the  
undersides or backs of drawers & the undersides of  
tables & counters. Scrape any visible Gel into  
cracks & crevices or remove. In new construction of  
walls, soffits, cabinets & flooring, apply to joints  
of basic structural supports before finished
