Resubmission of Amended Labeling (per PR Notice 94-7) Dated June 19, 1995

Dear Ms. Thompson,

Your application for amended registration, originally submitted January 16, 1995, included a proposed change in the product name from RAMIK RED to PROMAR BAIT PACKS Rat & Mouse Killer as well as a proposed change in the product formulation. A revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) was subsequently submitted on June 19, 1995 which indicates that the new product formulation would be a straight repack of EPA Reg. No. 2393-501. Your revised CSF and proposed product name change are acceptable. Please note that the revised CSF, dated June 19, 1995, supersedes all previous CSFs for EPA Reg. No. 61282-6. The formulation indicated on the June 19, 1995 CSF is now the only registered formulation and formulations listed on previous CSFs are NOT considered alternate formulations.

In addition, we note that EPA Reg. No. 2393-501 is a "loose bait" that will be repacked into 2-oz. placepacks under Reg. No. 61282-6. Placepack penetration data are needed to support the claim for control of mice as well as commensal rats. As indicated in your June 19, 1995 letter, adequate data on placepack penetration by Norway rats are available for a similar product (MRIDs 429785-01 and -02), and you have committed to conduct a study on placepack penetration by house mice which will be submitted within six months.

We have reviewed the amended labeling for the subject product, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act

(FIFRA), as amended, and pursuant to PR Notice 94-7. The amended labeling for both the outer and inner (placepack) packages is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Modify the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" section on both the outer package label and individual placepack labels as indicated below.
 - a. Change the first sentence of the "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS" for "Rats" to read
 - "Apply 2-8 placepacks per bait placement."
 - b. Change the first sentence of the "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS" for "Mice" to read

"Open pack and apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (1-2 level teaspoons) of bait at 8-to 12-foot intervals."

- 2. Amend the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" statement on the outer package label and individual placepack labels as indicated below.
 - a. On the outer package label, delete statement in parentheses "For Inner Containers."
 - b. On the individual placepack labels add the following sentence under the heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL"

"Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."

Under this sentence, add the paragraph of directions for "STORAGE" that appears on the proposed outer package label, i.e. "STORAGE: Store only in original closed container in a cool, dry place...."

- c. On both the proposed outer label and individual placepack labels, delete the directions for "DISPOSAL" and add directions for "PESTICIDE DISPOSAL" and "CONTAINER DISPOSAL" to both labels as indicated below.
 - 1) If your product is intended for both commercial and household uses, add the following directions:
