For crops such as Tobacco, Asparagus, Beans, Beets, Cabbage, Campts, Celery, Collards, Cucumbers, Egoplant, Endive, Kale, Kohlrabi, Lettuce, Melons, Mustard, Peas, Peopers, Radish, Spinsch, Swiss Chard, Tomatoes, Turnips, Apply 1 lb. to treat 500 to 600 sq. ft.
