Each Promar® Blox consists of either a 12 oz. block scored so that it can be broken into 12 one ounce pieces or a 16 oz block scored so that it can be broken into 16 one ounce pieces.

NORWAY AND ROOF RATS: Apply 4 to 16 one-ounce Promar® Blox per placement. Space placements at intervals of 15 to 30 feet in infested areas. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until there no longer are signs of new feeding by rats.

HOUSE MICE: Break Promar® Blox into discrete 1-ounce pieces. Apply one 1-ounce piece per placement. Space placements at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Placement of two 1-ounce pieces each may be needed at points of very high house mouse activity.
