The purpose of your submission under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is to revise your label according to our letter of January 6,

2003.

Label

The label submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling, including graphics, with the following change, to us before you release product for shipment. A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

1. Revise the first two sentences of the "DANGER" section as follows:

Fatal if swallowed or inhaled. May be fatal if absorbed through skin.

This change reflects an acute dermal toxicity study in Toxicity Category II. Could you submit a copy of the California review as the Zinc Phosphide Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED) document had listed Toxicity Category III for the acute dermal toxicity

Existing stocks

Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

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Consequence for non-compliance

If these conditions are not complied with, the registrations will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
