We have reviewed the subject materials and have the following comments.

1. Your redesign of the box and label, so that no hole will be on the bottom if the box is placed in the position required by the Label and the most striking (and, therefore, potentially most attractive to children) part of the label will be on the bottom of the correctly-placed box, is acceptable.
2. You indicate that this is a repack of your product number 61282-12, DPN Wax Blox. Under separate cover we are responding to your recent submissions for that product. Included in that response will be a requirement for provision of supplier names for all ingredients in the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) for 61282-12 dated March 18, 1994 and an acceptance of the same CSF, from an efficacy standpoint. As a result of the latter determination, this response will also indicate that the formulation in the March 18, 1994 CSF is the only one that may currently be used for product number 61282-12. The same condition also applies to the product that is the subject of this letter.

b. Modify the Storage and Disposal section to read as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original wrapping in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

3. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

4. Within 15 months of registration, submit the following studies:

a. Storage stability (GLN 63-17)

b. Corrosion Characteristics (GLN 63-20)

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

THIS IS NOT A TAMPER-PROOF OR TAMPER-RESISTANT BAIT STATION. DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT IN AREAS ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN, PETS, DOMESTIC ANIMALS, OR NONTARGET WILDLIFE. Use this product to control house mice (*Mus musculus*) in homes, and in industrial, commercial, or agricultural buildings. Do not place in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food, water, or surfaces that come in direct contact with other.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS

Determine areas where mice will most likely find and consume bait. Generally, these are along walls, by greased openings, beside burrows, or in corners and concealed places.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Place single MOUSE MAZE units at intervals of 8 to 12 feet along walls or in corners where mice or signs of mice have been seen. Replace MOUSE MAZE units if their contents are consumed or contaminated, or if the units are severely damaged. Units not touched after three days should be moved to new locations where mouse activity is evident and units can be placed without violating the requirements of this label.

Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.
