This product may only be used to control the following rodent pests in man-made structures: House mouse (*Mus musculus*), Eastern harvest mouse* (*Reithrodontomys humulis*), Golden mouse* (*Ochrotomys nuttalli*), and Meadow vole* (*Microtus pennsylvanicus*). Examples of such structures include homes and other permanent or temporary residences, food processing facilities, industrial and commercial buildings, agricultural and public buildings, transport vehicles, (ships, trains, aircraft), port or terminal buildings, and related structures around and associated with these sites.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where house mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Mice* and Meadow Voles*: Place a single [unit] [product name] at each placement location. Space placements at 8- to 12-foot internals. Replace units if contents are consumed or contaminated, or if units are severely damaged. If units are untouched after three days, move to new locations consistent with label text. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until there no longer are signs of new feeding by mice* or meadow voles*.

FOLLOW-UP: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Using barrier laminate gloves, collect and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait properly. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store only in original container in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.
