If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. 3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of Norway rats, roof rats and house mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. Do not place bait where there is a

possibility of contaminating food with food. Do not broadcast bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT

rats or mice will most likely find these areas are along walls, by gaps in corners and concealed places (locations where rodents or their droppings, urine or snow. Remove as much as possible.)

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Rats: Apply 3 to 10 bait packs per 100 sq ft. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait.

Mice: Apply one placepack per 100 sq ft at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Maintain bait for at least 15 days.

Rats/Mice: Replace containers as needed.

Collect and dispose of all dead rodents to prevent reinfestation, limit source of bait as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, replace bait.

Where a continuous source of bait is maintained, replace permanent bait stations and replace bait.

Pursuant to PR-Notice 98-10 and my e-mails with John Hebert, Team 4, Insecticide Rodenticide Branch, we are hereby notifying the Agency of two additional statements through Notification. The statements are as follows:
"Rats and Mice will eat through the bait pack"
"Satisfaction Guaranteed or your Money Back"

Following is my statement as required by PR-notice 98-10:

"On behalf of HACCO, Inc., I certify that this notification is consistent with the provisions of PR-Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to the EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with terms of PR-Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement actions and penalties under Sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

This product has completed the necessary bait pack penetration studies for both rats and mice, MRID Nos. 42978501 and 43855402. This is verified by our labeling which permits placements of the packs for both rats and mice. Likewise the Agency is not concerned about warranties which are not inconsistent with EPA policies. Attached are copies of my e-mails with John Hebert, referenced above.
