Wear waterproof gloves when applying bait. With detergent and hot water, wash all implements used for applying bait. Do not use these implements for mixing, holding or transferring foods or feeds.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Secure bait stations at locations where they will be readily accessible to target ground squirrels, preferably near active burrows. Secure stations 20 to 100 feet apart, depending upon the density of the California ground squirrel population. Use 2 to 4 pounds of bait per station.

Check bait stations frequently to insure that an uninterrupted supply of bait is always available. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 30 days or until all signs of feeding have stopped. Wearing waterproof gloves collect and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait properly.

Bait stations may be maintain in areas on permanent bases, but must only be loaded with toxic bait when California grounds squirrels are active and accepting grain-based foods in numbers sufficient to promote effective control
