Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats and/or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been observed. Remove as much food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Norway and Roof Rats:

Apply 4 to 16 BDF Chunks per placement. Space placements at intervals of 15-30 feet in infested areas. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until fresh signs of rat activity no longer are

Use one BDF Chunk per placement. Space placements at intervals of 8 to 12 feet. Two chunks may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead rodents and leftover bait properly. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, maintain permanent bait stations and
