Purpose This submission, under section 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), includes a supplemental label to clarify the application of this product at military airfields.

Labeling The labeling submitted with the above letter, is acceptable, provided that you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

1. Change "**FOR USE IN MILITARY AIRFIELDS**" to "**FOR USE ON GRASSY AREAS AT MILITARY AIRFIELDS**" at the two places that the phrase occurs.
2. Change "For control of vole complex (*Microtus spp.*) on military airfields." to "For control of meadow, pine, and prairie voles (*Microtus spp.*) on grassy areas at military airfields."
3. After "**CAUTION**", add "**(INCLUDING "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" AND "ENDANGERED SPECIES CONSIDERATIONS")**" after "**PRECAUTIONS**".
4. Add this text as the last portion of your "**USE RESTRICTIONS**" under "**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**":

Because this product is very highly toxic to grass-eating and grain-eating birds, time applications to avoid adverse effects on these and other nontarget species.

- Existing stocks** Stocks of this supplemental label may be used for eighteen (18) months.
- Consequence for non-compliance** If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Do not apply to bare ground or to any paved areas.

Do no use grass as feed or forage for livestock.

BROADCAST BAITING:

This product may be broadcast by ground driven dispensing devices only.

Apply Prozap® Zinc Phosphide Pellets at a rate up to 10 pounds (0.2 lb. active) per acre.

A second application may be made at a minimal interval of 30 days. 2nd application must follow the mowing and grass length use restriction above.

A maximum of 20 pounds (0.4 lb. active) per acre may be applied per year.
