Baiting:


Mice: Apply 1 to 2 teaspoons (4 to 8 grams) of this product per placement. Space placements at intervals of 15 to 30 feet along vertical surfaces in infested areas. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until new signs of feeding by rats have ceased to appear.

Rats: Apply 1 teaspoon (4 grams) of bait per placement. Space placements at intervals of 6- to 12-foot along vertical surfaces in infested areas. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until signs of new feeding by mice no longer appear.

Follow-up (Rats & Mice): Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and properly dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait. To discourage re-infestation, trace sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible and close off likely routes of entry into structures. Do not retreat the same area with this product at intervals of less than 30 days from end of the previous treatment period.

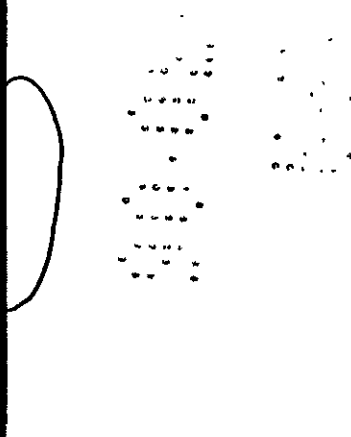

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Pursuant to PR-Notices 98-10, in regard to the subject product, we are hereby notifying the Agency of an additional packaging size for the following product: Prozap[®] Zinc Phosphide Rodent Oat Bait (1.25lb). As this size is between the currently listed sizes of 1 lb. and 4 lbs. and no other changes in the labeling are required, we are utilizing the Notification Process to clarify sizes of our packaging.

Following is my statement as required by PR-Notice 98-10:
