The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release this product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR § 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR § 152.3.

The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Accepted Only Indicated Revisions Reviewed" and is enclosed for your records.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to your company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by EPA. IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets or other non-target animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.

2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and non-target wildlife.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS:

Bait stations are mandatory. Tamper-resistant bait stations must be used wherever children, pets, non-target mammals or birds may have access to the bait placement location.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT OUTDOORS OR IN AREAS ACCESSIBLE TO PETS.

This product may only be used to control the following rodent pests in man-made structures: House mouse (*Mus musculus*), Eastern harvest mouse (*Reithrodontomys humuli*)*, Golden mouse (*Ochrotomys nuttalli*)*, and Meadow vole (*Microtus pennsylvanicus*)*. Examples of such structures include homes and other permanent or temporary residences, food processing facilities, industrial and commercial buildings, agricultural and public buildings, transport vehicles, (ships, trains, aircraft), port or terminal buildings and related structures around and associated with these sites.

Do not place near or inside ventilation duct openings. Do not contaminate water, food, feedstuffs, food or feed handling equipment, or milk or meat handling equipment or surfaces that come into direct contact with food. When used in USDA inspected facilities, this product must be applied in tamper-resistant bait stations.

Do not sell this product in individual container holding less than 4 pounds of bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where mice or meadow voles will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

{For 8 oz size} Each Ramik bait bar consists of two 4 oz bars scored so that it can be broken into 8 one-ounce pieces.

{For 16 oz size} Each Ramik bait bar consists of four 4 oz bars scored so that it can be broken into 16 one-ounce pieces.

MICE AND MEADOW VOLES*: While wearing barrier laminate gloves, break [bait bar] [this product] into individual one-ounce pieces. Place 1 one-ounce piece Mini-Bar in the bait station. [See images for loading instructions] Place the bait station at highest point of activity along a wall or in corner where mice or meadow voles or their signs have been seen. If additional units are to be used, place bait stations at 8 to 12-foot intervals. While wearing barrier laminate gloves, replace bait in bait station when bait is consumed or contaminated. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until there are no longer signs of new feeding by mice or meadow voles.

FOLLOW-UP: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Using barrier laminate gloves collect and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait properly. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.

OPENING THE STATION: 1. Wearing gloves, place bait station on a hard surface. Position pushkey in the slot at the front of the closed bait station as shown. With firm downward pressure, push the pushkey straight down into the slot until you hear a click. **DO NOT TURN THE PUSHKEY.** 2. Holding the base of the bait station with one hand, lift the top holding on to the pushkey with your other hand.



LOADING THE BAIT: 3. Place bait bar into the station's bait compartment marked "Place Bait Here" as shown. Do not place bait in any other location within the station.



CLOSING THE STATION: 4. With downward pressure, push top down until you hear a click.
