You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where house mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners, and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OPENING, REFILLING & RECLOSING THE MOUSE BAIT STATION

1. To open the Bait Station, put on gloves and insert the plastic key into the lock on top of the Bait Station lid. Push the key all the way down into the lock and turn key in the direction of the arrow to open the station lid.

2. REMOVE AND SAVE THE KEY

3. Remove the plastic bait holder and discard any remaining bait from bot the holder and the bait station. Place one refill block of bait into each side of the plastic bait holder, with center holes facing upward.



4. Insert plastic bait holder with two refill baits into the **MIDDLE COMPARMENT** of the Bait Station as shown below.



APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

The active ingredient in this product is different from anticoagulant rodenticides. Individual mice cease feeding after consuming a toxic dose.

House Mice: Place bait stations 8 to 12 feet apart in infested areas. Highest bait consumption is expected to occur on the first day or two after treatment. After several days, inspect bait

placements and mouse activity. Continue baiting unit all signs of house mouse activity have ceased.

FOLLOW-UP: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. While wearing gloves, collect and properly dispose of all dead house mice and used bait station. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Keep containers closed and away from other chemicals.
