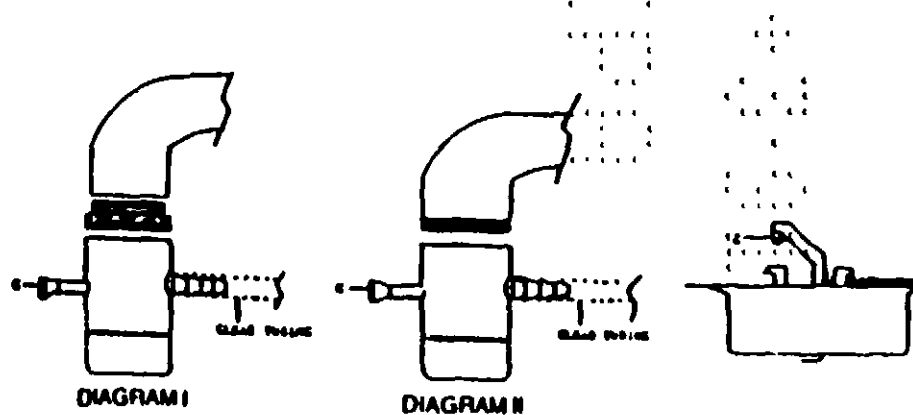

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

MODEL. MK-30..... Counter Top

1. Place unit on counter with spout hanging over sink and uncoil the tubing. Lay the "diverter head" on top of the sink by faucet.
2. Remove existing aerator from kitchen faucet.
3. If faucet has threads on inside, refer to DIAGRAM I. If faucet has threads on outside, refer to DIAGRAM II.
4. DIAGRAM II. In most instances the faucet will have threads on the outside. If yours does, simply attach diverter and tighten onto the faucet.
5. DIAGRAM I. If your faucet has threads on the inside, then you will need to use the enclosed adapter. Simply attach the adapter to your existing faucet, then attach diverter and tighten. Make sure to use rubber washer between adapter and faucet spout.
6. After diverter is attached to faucet. Make sure no crimps are in tubing. Position tubing along the faucet so it is snug. Move the faucet from left to right making sure the faucet moves freely without disturbing the water unit. It is important that the water purification unit remain stationary so it will not be tipped over.
7. PLEASE NOTE: When installing your system, a common pair of pliers is all that is needed. You may want to use an old rag over the fittings to avoid any scratching. Should your sink faucet be an odd size and the enclosed adapter ring not work, then you will need a "universal kit". They are available at any hardware store.
8. Turn on cold water. (CAUTION: NEVER RUN HOT WATER THROUGH THIS UNIT.) Pull diverter pin (c) to activate unit. It will take a few seconds for the water to come out of the spout at the top of the unit.
9. Run water for approximately 10-15 minutes until water becomes clear. This process will flush the system and prepare it for your use.
