



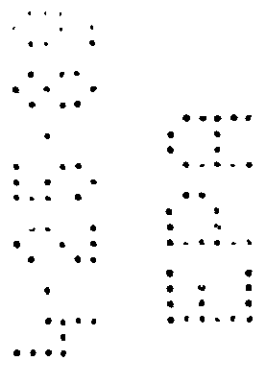

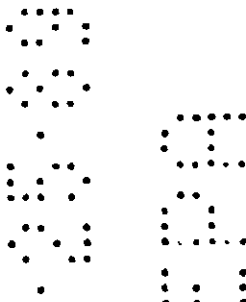

WATER PRESERVER was developed to be used exclusively with Emergency Storage Pak water containers, specially designed for long term water storage.

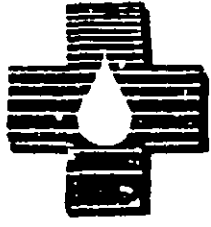

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

- 1) Store WATER PRESERVER away from heat and sunlight. Keep in a locked storage area AWAY FROM CHILDREN. Always keep tightly capped. Do not use after date marked on bottle.
- 2) Disposal of empty container: wrap original container in newspaper and discard in trash. Do not reuse container.

EMERGENCY WATER PREPARATION:

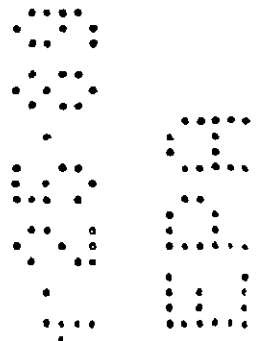
- 1) Remove safety seal from cap. Do not use if safety seal is broken or missing.
- 2) Prepare your Emergency Storage Pak containers by rinsing out thoroughly with water. Rinse cap also.
- 3) Add 20 drops WATER PRESERVER to each empty 2.5 gallon container (8 drops per gallon).
- 4) Fill container with regular tap water to 3 inches below cap.
- 5) Cap container tightly and place bottles into storage case.
- 6) Mark the date of water preparation on the outside of the storage box.

PROPER WATER STORAGE

7) STORE your filled Emergency Storage Pak containers in a cool dry place, avoid excessive heat and direct sunlight.

NEVER STORE EMERGENCY DRINKING WATER NEAR STORED GASOLINE, KEROSENE, PESTICIDES OR SIMILAR SUBSTANCES THAT CAN CONTAMINATE YOUR WATER.

8) Once your water has been prepared, do not reopen the container until the water is needed. Opening the container can introduce contamination.

WATER STORAGE LIFE

LABORATORY TESTS have shown that water properly prepared and stored using Emergency Storage Pak WATER PRESERVER will remain bacteriologically suitable for drinking for a minimum of 3 years, with a projected shelf life of 5 years. Change water more often if possible.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waterways unless in accordance with a NPDES permit. For guidance, contact the regional office of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
