The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

General Comments:

Upon submission of the final printed labels, the Confidential Statements of Formula (CSF's) must be updated to reflect the current registrant and address information.

Labeling Comments:

- 1. Page 1
 - a. Place an ")" after the "(CAS# 22248-79-9" within the ingredient statement.
 - b. The ingredients percentages must be decimal aligned.
- 2. Page 2
 - a. Within the Conditions of Sale and Limitations of Warranty and Liability section, revise the sentence "In no event shall KMG-BERNUTH INC or seller to be liable for any incidental consequential or special damages resulting from the use or handling of this product." to: "It is KMG-BERNUTH INC intention that to the extent allowable under state law, KMG-BERNUTH INC, or the Seller shall not be liable for any incidental consequential or special damages resulting from the use or handling of this product."
- 3. Page 3
 - a. Move the boxed section entitled "FOR CHEMICAL EMERGENCY" to the front panel of the label. (shown below)

FOR CHEMICAL EMERGENCY. Spill, leak, fire, exposure, or accident call CHEMTREC 1-800-424-9300.

b. Revise the Personal Protective Equipment statement as follows:

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PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

"Some materials that are chemical-resistant to this product are" (registrant inserts correct chemical-resistant material)¹. "If you want more options, follow the instructions for category" [registrant inserts A,B,C,D,E,F,G,or H]¹ "on an EPA chemical-resistance category selection chart."

"Mixers, loaders, applicators and other handlers supporting dusting applications must wear:

- Coveralls over long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- Chemical resistant footwear plus socks
- Chemical resistant gloves
- -A NIOSH-approved dust mist filtering respirator with MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C or a NIOSH-approved respirator with any N, R, P, or HE filter."

Loaders and others handling dust bags must wear:

- long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- socks and shoes
- chemical resistant gloves.
- c. Revise the language within the **USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS** section as follows:

"USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables exist, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. Discard clothing and other absorbent materials that have been heavily contaminated with this product's concentrate. Do not reuse them."

d. Revise the language within the USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS section as follows:

"USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Users Should:

Remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing. Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet."

4. Page 4

a. Within the Directions for Use re-arrange the statements as follows:

"DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read the entire label prior to use.

This product is a ready to use insecticide dust. There is no withholding period from last application to slaughter. Apply as directed."

- b. Next, insert the following new text after the sentence "Apply as directed." listed in 4.a. above:
 - "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Cover or remove all food/feed and water prior to use of this product. Do not apply this product during dairy milking operations."
- c. Insert a new box after the revisions identified in 4.b. above, as follows:

Non-Agricultural Use Restriction

Do not enter or allow others to enter until dusts have settled"

d. Revise the Storage and Disposal Statement as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in cool dry location in original container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site in accordance with the label directions, or at an approved waste disposal facility. Open dumping is prohibited.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: DO NOT reuse empty container. Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill, or incinerate, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e).
