Dear Mr. Hathorn:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

First Aid Statement comment(s):

- 1. In the "HOTLINE NUMBER" subsection, it is important to note that the "1-800-322-8177" phone number should be available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week for answering and responding to any medical emergencies or health concerns.
- 2. In the **"NOTE TO PHYSICIAN"** subsection, replace the 1st sentence with: "This product contains tetrachlorvinphos (an organophosphate), which is a cholinesterase inhibitor."

Warranty & Disclaimer section comment(s):

3. Within forty-five (45) days from the date of this letter, KMG-Bernuth, Inc. should submit a label amendment revising the "CONDITIONS OF SALE AND LIMITATION OF WARRANTY AND LIABILITY" section (label statement at top of page 2 of 5, in accordance with the guidance document entitled, "Guidance on Warranty Statements," dated October 17, 2006. This update can be found at the following hyperlink: http://www.epa.gov/pesticides/regulating/labels/warranty.pdf.

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s):

4. You should replace the 5th sentence with: "Wash hands thoroughly with plenty of soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."

Precautionary Statements, User Safety Recommendations subsection comment(s):

5. You should replace the 6th sentence with: "Wash hands thoroughly with plenty of soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."

Directions for Use, Beef Cattle & Dairy Cattle subsection comment(s):

6. Insert the following sentence immediately following the last sentence of the 1st row in the "Remarks" column: "Do not apply to livestock more frequently than 1 time per day."

<u>Directions for Use, Swine subsection comment(s)</u>:

7. Replace the 2nd sentence of the 1st row in the "Remarks" column with: "Apply no more than every 14 days, if necessary."

Directions for Use, Poultry subsection comment(s):

- 8. Revise the "Type of Housing" column of this subsection by revising "Wire Cages" and "Floor Management Litter" to read: "Wire Cages (Indoors)" and "Floor Management Litter (Indoors)."
- 9. In the "Remarks" column of the 1st row of this subsection, replace the 4th sentence with "Apply no more than once every 14 days, if necessary."

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s):

10. To facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-4, you should replace the "CONTAINER DISPOSAL:" subsection with: "CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Completely empty bag into application into application equipment, then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities."

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.
