b. Revise the last sentence of the Physical and Chemical Hazards to read: Mixing this product with chemicals (e.g. ammonia, acids, detergent, etc.) or organic matter (e.g. urine, feces, etc.) will result in the release of hazardous gases which are irritating to eyes, lungs and mucous membranes.

c. Delete the word "Interim" from the Swimming Pool Directions.

3. Certification regarding Child-Resistant Packaging (CRP) and compliance with the standards of 40 CFR 157.32 including the revised effectiveness standards in 16 CFR 1700.15(b), and the revised testing procedures in 16 CFR 1700.20 as published in 60 FR 37710 (July 21, 1995) must be submitted prior to product shipment.
