CROPS

Pears, to prevent scald. Wrap within 1 week post-harvest. Do not use impregnated wraps on fruit which has been previously treated with Ethoxyquin pre-harvest or post-harvest.
 Do not re-use fruit wrap.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool place. Prolonged exposure of chemical to air of sunlight may result in darkening of the product and staining of the fruit. Dispose of in on site trash collection or at approved waste disposal facility. Open dumping is prohibited.
