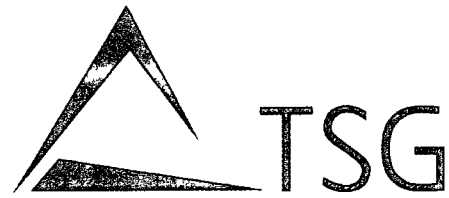

Dear Mr Kish

On behalf of Wrap Pack Corporation Technology Sciences Group Inc submits this notification for the subject product to make the following changes

- 1 Wrap Pack intends to replace the use of Roman Numerals in its brand names so it requests EPA change the product name to Pear Wrap 4 rather than Pear Wrap IIII
- 2 As provided for in the Label Review Manual Wrap Pack is adding to the First Aid Statements the advice to take the product container or label when going for treatment
- 3 Wrap Pack is correcting a typo in the User Safety Requirements by adding all to washables
- 4 Wrap Pack is changing the Pesticide Storage statement to replace chemicals with wraps which is a more accurate description of the product
