The following label revisions must be made on all versions of the label (9x9, 10x10, 11x11 and 12x12).

1. Per the acute toxicity review, the following statement must be added to the First Aid statement:

"IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

2. The Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals must be revised to read as follows:

"CAUTION  
Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, and chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, selection category A. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."

3. Per the RED, the following User Safety Requirements text must be added to the label:

"Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables exist, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry."

4. Per the RED, the following User Safety Recommendations must be added to the label and be placed in a box:

"User Safety Recommendations

User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, tobacco, or using the toilet.

User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing."

5. The name of record with the Agency for this product is Pear Wrap I. Please revise label.

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6. The Storage and Disposal section must be revised to read as follows:

**"Storage and Disposal**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool place. Prolonged exposure of chemical to air or Sunlight may result in darkening of the product and staining of the fruit.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Place discarded pear wraps in trash.

**Container Disposal:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available or dispose of box in a sanitary landfill or by other Procedures approved by state and local authorities."

7. Per page 14 of RED, you must add the following statement: "Persons sorting, packing, culling, or otherwise handling treated pear and persons handling impregnated paper wrap are considered handlers and must wear handler PPE. Gloves – Category A- polyvinyl chloride, nitrile rubber, or butyl rubber."

8. The Ingredient Statement must be moved to the top of the label under the "Treated with Ethoxyquin" statement.

9. Move the "CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" statement to appear Directly above the First Aid box.

10. The Precautionary Statement must be moved directly after the First Aid statement.

11. The PPE should appear after the Precautionary Statement, followed by the User Safety Instructions, User Safety Recommendations and the Directions for Use.

12. Storage and Disposal should appear last on the label and placed in a box.

Per the Product Chemistry review dated December 5, 2007, a waiver for Storage Stability has been requested, however, no justification for the waiver was found. In addition, the statement "N/A" for Corrosion Characteristics is not acceptable, if not accompanied by proper justification, both are requirements at this time, and are identified as data gaps. You must submit the data by March 30, 2010.

This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling incorporation the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supersede all previously

accepted labels. A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records.

**Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.**  
**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool place. Prolonged exposure of chemical to air of sunlight may result in darkening of the product and staining of the fruit.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Waste resulting from use of this product must be disposed of on-site (according to label instructions), or at an approved waste disposal facility.
