PEAR WRAP I TREATED WITH ETHOXYOUIN

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Ethoxyquin (6-ethoxy-1,2-dihydro-2,2,4-trimethylquinoline) 0.1% INERT INGREDIENTS: 99.9% TOTAL: 100.0%

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN CAUTION

FIRST AID

<u>IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:</u> Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. <u>IF IN EYES</u>: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Persons sorting, packing, culling, or otherwise handling treated pear and persons handling impregnated paper wrap are considered handlers and must wear handler PPE. Gloves- Category A-on an EPA chemical-resistance category selection chart, polyvinyl chloride, nitrile tubber, or butyl rubber. Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, and chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, selection category A.

USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washable exist, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, tobacco, or using the toilet. User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. User should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing. Wash the outside of gloves before removing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CROPS: Pears - Wrap within 1 week post-harvest to prevent scald. These treated pear wraps contain a maximum of 1,000 ppm ethoxyquin. They can be used on pears that have received prior treatment with ethoxyquin providing those pears were sprayed only once with no more than 1700 ppm of ethoxyquin, or drenched only once with no more than 1,000 ppm of ethoxyquin. Do not re-use fruit wrap.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool place. Prolonged exposure of the wrap to air or sunlight may result in darkening of the product and staining of the fruit.

Pesticide Disposal: Place discarded pear wraps in trash. Container Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse this container. Offer for recycling if available or dispose of box in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities
