ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. ALGAE FIGHTER 40 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using ALGAE FIGHTER 40. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 18 to 27 fluid ounces of ALGAE FIGHTER 40 per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 10 to 18 fluid ounces of ALGAE FIGHTER 40 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent addition of 3.5 to 7 fluid ounces of ALGAE FIGHTER 40 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 3 fluid ounces of ALGAE FIGHTER 40 per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned spa, whirlpool, hot tub, decorative fountain or pond, add initially 1 to 2 fluid ounces of ALGAE FIGHTER 40 per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.4 to 1 fluid ounces of ALGAE FIGHTER 40 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

ALGAE FIGHTER 40 is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. ALGAE FIGHTER 40 can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix ALGAE FIGHTER 40 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

FIRST AID

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash.
