Wait three minutes, then wipe excess with damp sponge or cloth. Apply to pet bedding to control fleas. Keeps repelling for weeks.

OUTDOOR USE

Spray perimeter of home generously to make a barrier of protection. Spray doorways, window frames, cracks – anywhere an insect can enter. Saturate until visibly wet. Saturate areas of trails or nests. Spray garbage cans, manure piles or any infested areas until visibly wet.



Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat procedure two more times.

Container Handling For Greater than 5 gallons: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill container. Offer for recycling, if available. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.
