

Direction for Use: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Fire Ant Control: Use Orange Guard full strength or dilute 1 part with 3 parts water. Mounds are treated using a drench and puncture method. Each mound is drenched with a half gallon using a pressurized sprayer.

Start spraying around the edge of the mound, stand back and puncture with a 5 ft broom handle 1/2" in diameter to a depth of 8" to 12". Make sure Orange Guard penetrates into the punctures in the soil. Saturate ant trails and around the base of trees and shrubs.

For Structure Protection: Spray perimeter of structure generously (full strength). Spray doorways, cracks, window frames - anywhere ants may enter. Saturate until visibly wet. In kitchens, pantries, or any infested areas spray from 8" to 12" directly on ants. Saturate, wait 3 minutes and wipe excess with damp cloth.

Storage: Store only in original container, in a cool dry place, inaccessible to children.

Disposal: Do not reuse container unless refilled with Orange Guard.

Rinse thoroughly. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.
