The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 98-10, dated November June 13, 2013, for the product Orange Guard Fire Ant Control; EPA Registration Number 61887-2. The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of these requests for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested: change in address, addition of a patent number, and dropping of AA from EPA Registration Number, falls within the scope of PRN 98-10. The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records. Make sure Orange Guard penetrates into the punctures in the soil. Saturate ant trails and around the base of trees and shrubs.

FOR STRUCTURE PROTECTION: Spray perimeter of structure generously (full strength). Spray doorways, cracks, window frames - anywhere ants may enter. Saturate until visibly wet. In kitchens, pantries, or any infested areas spray from 8" to 12" directly on ants. Saturate, wait 3 minutes and wipe excess with damp cloth.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Pesticide Storage: Store only in original container in a cold dry place, inaccessible to children and domestic animals. Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling if Empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partially filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
