3. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 62128-3."
- b. Add the dispenser weight to the label ingredient statement. A footnote to the label ingredient statement indicating number of dispensers per package, net weight of an individual dispenser and amount of active ingredient per dispenser is recommended.
- c. Remove "Associated Impurities. . .4.2%" from the Active Ingredients portion of the label, recalculate it based on the CSF (% by total weight of the dispenser) and add it to the inert Ingredients portion of the label.
- d. Add the phrase "Use 400 - 500 stakes per acre." to the DIRECTIONS FOR USE portion of the label.
- e. Add the phrase "Stakes do not need to be removed from the field after application." to the PRODUCT DISPOSAL portion of the label.
- f. Delete the phrase "For Ingestion, dilute with 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting. Consult a physician."
- g. Change the phrase "For eye contact, flush with running water for at least 15 minutes." to "For eye contact, flush eyes with plenty of water."
- h. Add the phrase "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling." to the HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS portion of the label.

4. Provide a sample of the dispenser to the Agency.

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is intended to be used for control of the cotton bollworm (*Pectinophora gossypiella*) in cotton. It is not intended to control male moths from finding and mating with females.

Insert stakes securely into the ground, with the top of the stake at least 1 foot above the soil surface. Use sufficient height above the soil to avoid burial. Use a minimum of 400 stakes per acre. Distribute the stakes evenly over the entire acre. For an area to be protected should be at least 1/4 acre. Use immediately prior to pin square or the insect pest population occurs. Stakes should be replaced two months after initial application if the pest persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, well ventilated area, away from ignition sources. Avoid contact with acids, bases. Store sealed to prevent loss.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: This product has been formulated for ease of use and minimization of waste. The product or wastes resulting from the use of this product may be used on site, or must be disposed of in accordance with applicable Federal, State or Local regulations.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Dispose of container in a sanitary landfill or by burning, if allowed by State and local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke.
