· DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read "Limit of Warranty and Liability" before buying or using. If such terms are not acceptable, return at once unopened. Contents for use only in pressure-treating forest products. To be used only in the pressure impregnation of forest products utilizing water solutions having concentrations ranging from 7 to 22 percent by weight. Impregnation procedures must rigidly adhere to the current specifications of Arch Wood Protection and/or those of the American Wood Protection Association. Pressure treatment of forest products with DRICON fire retardant provides wood with protection against termites and decay producing fungi. This product is toxic to termites of the Reticulotermes genus but etching of treated wood may occur.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Open dumping is prohibited.

Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: [For containers < 5 gallons] Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. Triple rinse as follows: Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

If not available, puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill.

Nonrefillable Container. Do not refill or reuse container. Triple rinse as follows: Fill container ¼ full with water. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times.
