1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes:
  - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 62190-13".
  - b. The proposed label contains two signal words. Delete "Caution", which appears directly below the statement Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals. Under "Directions For Use", add a statement such as "Only for use as a fungicide in the formulation of wood preservatives." (continued on page 2)

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3. Revise column 13b on your Confidential Statement of Formula dated June 2, 1995 so that the percentages by weight add up to 100 %.

4. Submit five copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
