Mixing must be done with caution only by those individuals properly trained and strictly in accordance to detailed instructions provided by Arch Wood Protection, Inc. Further information and assistance in solving particular problems is available from Arch Wood Protection technical staff.

USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions exist for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. Users should wash hands before eating, drinking chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside.
