Revise the "Pesticide Disposal" section to be in agreement with PR Notice 83-3, Storage and Disposal Statements by deleting the current language and replacing it with the statement, "Wastes resulting from the use of this product must disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product can be used alone or with any other EPA registered product as an Insecticide or fungicide for wood treatment.

Contents for use only in treating wood products. This product can be used with any other EPA product registered for wood uses. When adding Arch BA to any other wood preservation products, the concentration of Arch BA must range from 0.05 percent to 4.0 percent by weight (of the finished wood product), foptional: Impregnation procedures must rigidly adhere to the current specifications of Arch Wood Protection and/or the American Wood Protection Association.] Processes used to apply Arch BA formulations shall leave no visible surface deposits on the wood, as defined by AWPA Standards.
