Dear Ms. Square:

The Agency has reviewed your request for an amendment submitted in accordance with continuing registration under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, and determined the action acceptable.

In summary, our review of your Storage and Stability data, MRID 49065702, indicate a drop in the nominal concentration of the lower certified limit and confirms your request to amend the label. The statement "Use this product within 3 months of the date of manufacture" will be added to the use directions as requested. According to your description of this product's manufacture, Dricon Solution (4.5% BA) is generally made to order and blended directly into bulk tanker trucks and used soon afterwards. For these customers, the date of manufacture is on the bill of lading that accompanies the shipment. In addition, the data submitted for the Enforcement Analytical method and the Physical and Chemical properties, MRIDs 49065701 and 49065703, have been reviewed and are acceptable. A copy of our Chemistry review (DP412418) is enclosed.
