

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

[This product] {or} [brand name] is for use to treat wood and wood components made from wood such as door jambs sills and window joinery It is intended for use to control wood decay fungi

Wood preparation Perform necessary machining cutting and gluing of wood before treating Wood must be clean and dry before treatment and must have been kiln dried to permit adequate penetration of preservative during treatment Do not apply over previously applied wood finish including stains or paints

Treatment [This product] {or} [brand name] is a ready to use solution that does not require dilution before use Apply by dip spray flood brush or pressure treatment (double vacuum process) For surface applications one gallon of this product will cover approximately 150 sq ft but varies with wood species and condition For pressure applications the recommended rate of application is 30 liters of solution per cubic meter

Post treatment After treatment wood must be held on the drip pad until dripping has stopped and then conditioned in a ventilated area to remove excess solvent until the wood is completely dry and odor free

Treated wood must not be used or placed where it may contact food or animal feed

Clean up Use mineral spirits to clean application equipment

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water food or feed by storage or disposal Open dumping is prohibited Do not reuse empty container

**PESTICIDE STORAGE** Protect from physical damage Store in a clean dry well ventilated area Keep away from incompatible chemicals and from unguarded flame sparks and heat sources To reduce flammability hazard store in PVC polypropylene or polyethylene containers Do not store in metal containers Do not store above 104 F

Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

{For containers <5 gallons}

Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

**[CONTAINER DISPOSAL** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. Triple rinse container promptly after emptying. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.]

{OR }

**[CONTAINER DISPOSAL** Refillable container. Refill this container with this pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose. Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean the container before final disposal empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or mix tank. Fill the container about 10 percent full with water.
