Dear Ms. Simpson:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- To update the "first aid" statement in accordance with PR Notice 2001-1.

**Conditions**

- Place the "Environmental Hazards" statement on your label

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS STATEMENT: This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms.

- You must place an "EPA Establishment Number" on your label:
- Under the "First Aid" statement add the statement "Have the product container or label with you when you call a poison control center or doctor, or when going for treatment"
- Under the "First Aid" statement revise as follow:

**If In Eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lens, if present after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**If Swallowed** Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If on Skin or Clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
