- c. Although inclusion is encouraged, it has been determined that it is acceptable to delete the phrase "...take this repellent with you" from the product label language.
- d. Delete the Physical Hazards section and add the following:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Wrap empty container and dispose in trash receptacle.

- e. Upon review of the submitted acute toxicity data, it has been determined that the acute oral, acute dermal, and skin irritation studies are acceptable and have been graded core guideline. The eye irritation and the dermal sensitization studies are acceptable as core minimum data, and the acute inhalation study is unacceptable. See the enclosed toxicity review. Since the subject product can not be aerosolized, a repeat study is not required. You may elect to submit a data waiver request based upon the inability to aerosolize the undiluted test material. The toxicity studies have been assigned the MRID numbers as follows:

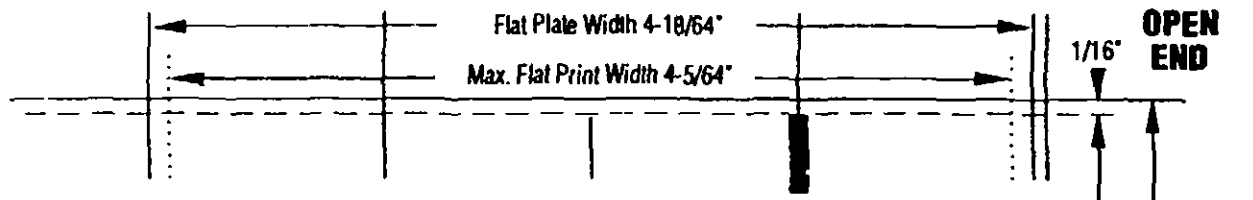

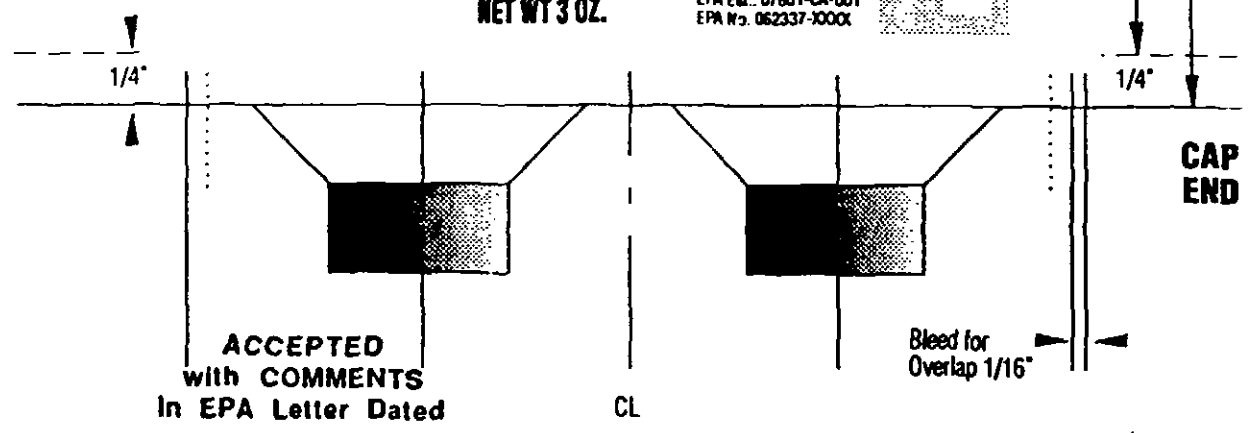
