Dear Mr. Standley:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the conditions listed below.

- Update as per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

1. Your label includes the site "farm areas". As such your label is required to include directions for use on farms as per DIS/TSS 18. Revise your label to include the following language:

- "1. Remove all animals and feed from premise, vehicles, and enclosures.*
- 2. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes, and other facilities and fixtures occupied and traversed by animals.*
- 3. Empty all troughs, racks, and other feeding and watering appliances.*
- 4. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water.*
- 5. Saturate all surfaces with the recommended sanitizing solution for a period of 1 minute.*

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6. Immerse all halters, ropes, and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals, as well as forks, shovels, and scrapers used for removing litter and manure.

7. Ventilate buildings, cars, boats, and other closed spaces. Do not house livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set, or dried.

8. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains, and waterers with soap or detergent and rinse with potable water before reuse."

2. Revise the label by making the noted revisions to the following statements and moving them to the "Directions for Use" section of the label: (these statements currently appear on the left panel of the label immediately below the product name) "For sanitizing food processing equipment *which is too large to immerse* and sink tops, counter tops, refrigerated storage and display equipment, and other *similar hard nonporous* surfaces. No potable water rinse is *allowed*."

3. Revise the "Precautionary Statements" to read exactly as follows: "CAUTION: Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after contact."

4. Delete the "Environmental Hazards" statement as it is not required for this container size (32 ounces).

5. Revise the "Storage and Disposal" section as follows:

A. Delete the following statement which is not required for this container size: "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."

B. Revise the last statement to include: "Use locked storage to prevent access by persons unfamiliar with its use in an area that will prevent cross contamination..."

C. Add the following statement at the end of this section: "Wrap and discard in trash."

6. Make the following revisions to the "Directions for Use":

A. "Do not use on glasses, cookware, or eating utensils."

B. Make the following revision: "...from surface by preflushing, prescraping, or presoaking equipment. Clean thoroughly with detergent solution. Rinse with potable water"

C. Delete the following statements as they do not appear to be accurate for a product in a ready to use spray bottle: "Should the solution of HY-Q-75 SP....discard. Do not use soiled solution to sanitize."

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D. Add the following statement: "Before use as a sanitizer in federally inspected meat and poultry plants and dairies, food products and packaging material must be removed from the room or carefully protected."

General Comments

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

Spray HY-Q-75 SP directly onto the clean surface until thoroughly wetted. Surfaces should remain wet for at least one minute. Allow to drain and air dry. Do not rinse. At 300 ppm active ingredient solution strength, HY-Q-75 SP meets the requirements of 21 CFR 178.1010 as a no-rinse sanitizer. Should the solution of HY-Q-75 SP become diluted or soiled, discard. Do not use soiled solution to sanitize.
