SECTA is designed for gardeners who desire an acceptable alternative to organo-phosphate pesticides. SECTA is gentle to plants. It is an effective insecticide made from specially formulated potassium salts of fatty acids (insecticidal soap). SECTA penetrates and damages the outer shells of soft bodied insect pests, causing dehydration and death within hours of contact. SECTA effectively kills listed insects on plants in your homes, home gardens, and home greenhouses. SECTA does not destroy insect eggs, therefore, several applications may be necessary for complete successful control. SECTA can be used right up to day of harvest.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mix 3 1/2 ozs. of SECTA insecticide concentrate per gallon of soft water (or 2 Tbsps. per quart). Spray when insects first appear or damage is noticed. Thoroughly spray all infested areas to the point of runoff, hitting insects directly with insecticide spray where possible. Apply weekly as needed (repeat application after 2 or 3 days to control Aphids and Mealybugs). Can be used right up to the day of harvest.

For Use on Vegetables including: Asparagus, beans, beets, broccoli, cabbage, cucumbers, eggplants, lettuce, peas, peppers, potatoes, radishes, spinach, squash, and tomatoes.

For Use on Flowers & Bedding Plants (indoors & out) including: Foliage plants, roses & succulents.

For Use on Fruits & Nuts including: Apples, blackberries, cherries, cranberries, English walnuts, grapes, grapefruits, lemons, melons, oranges, peaches, pears, pecans, plums and strawberries.

For Use on Woody Landscape Shrubs & Trees including: Fir trees & evergreens.

Kills: Adelgids, aphids, cabbageworms, earwigs, flea beetles, lace bugs, leafhoppers, mealybugs, mites, plant bugs, psyllids, rose slugs, sawfly larvae, scale insects, squash bugs, stink bugs, tent caterpillars, thrips, & whiteflies.
