Spray when insects first appear or damage is noticed. Thoroughly spray all infested areas to the point of runoff, hitting insects directly with insecticide spray where possible. Apply weekly as needed (repeat application after 2 or 3 days to control Aphids and Mealybugs).
Can be used up to day of harvest.

For Use on Vegetables including: Asparagus, beans, beets, broccoli, cabbage, cucumbers, eggplants, lettuce, peas, peppers, potatoes, radishes, spinach, squash, and tomatos.

For Use on Flowers & Bedding Plants (indoors & out) including: Foliage plants, roses & succulents.
