#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants grown in ornamental gardens and home vegetable gardens.

**Entry Restrictions:** Do not allow people or pets to enter the treated area until dusts have settled. If watering-in is required after application, do not enter or allow others to enter the treated areas (except those involved in the watering) until the watering-in is complete and the surface is dry.

**Application Restrictions:** Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Keep people and pets out of the area during application.

- 3. **Post Emergent:** Cantaloupe, Cucumber, Watermelon. **Apply after plants have produced 3-4 true leaves.**
- 4. **Asparagus:** Established only. Apply after ferns are removed, but prior to spear emergence. Lightly mix product into soil with rake and water.
- 5. **Potato** (except Maine): May be applied after planting, before or after potato plant emergence. Use care not to damage seed pieces when mixing product into soil, nor to allow treated soil to contact emerged plant foliage.


