Subject: Response to PR Notice 91-4 (DEET LIP) and PRN 91-7
Skeeter Stop 100
EPA Reg. No. 62424-1
Submission: March 25, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) Remove the name "DEET" from the Active ingredient statement.
- 2) Remove the word "Concentrated" from the front label. Concentrated seems to indicate that the product needs to be diluted.

Although we still encourage inclusion, we have determined that it is acceptable to exclude the statement from your label, "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you". You do not need to submit an amendment to remove this from your label.

We have accepted this label with the assumption that all back label language will be on the bottle. In your conversation with Bob Brennis on April 9, you indicated it may be necessary to reduce the language on the back label and, instead, include it on a blister card. Some items (such as EPA Reg. No. and Precautionary Statements) could be shifted to the front label. We ask that as much of the human warning statements and label improvement statements be included on the bottle as is possible. Please indicate clearly in any resubmission, which language is intended for the label on the bottle and which language for the blister pack.

Do not apply over cuts, wounds, sunburned or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.
