1) Change the Ingredient Statement to read as follows:

N,N-diethyl-meta-toluamide... 95% other isomers..... 5%

It is acceptable for you to use the claim of 100% DEET elsewhere on your label but the Ingredient statement must appear as indicated.

2) The data we have reviewed on 100% DEET products indicate that these products are toxicity category II for eye irritation. Either submit or cite data to indicate that the toxicity category should not be II, or change the signal words on your label from Caution to Warning and change the precautionary statements for eye irritation accordingly.
