The AntGuard system repels ants. The protective disk inside the AntGuard device prevents ants from reaching the hummingbird feeder.

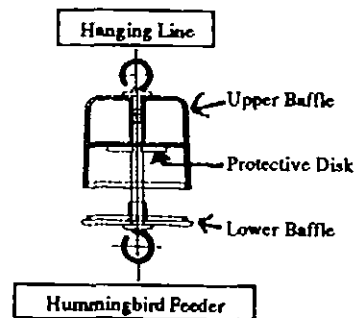

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Ants are attracted to the nectar on which hummingbirds feed. As ants forage to seek the nectar, they enter into the patented AntGuard device. The inside contains a disk which repels ants. Scout ants return to their nest and warn the other ants of the AntGuard. AntGuard is designed to keep rain off the repellent disk and to protect the nectar supply.

To Install: After cleaning out your birdfeeder and adding new nectar, remove unit from package and extend the lower baffle (see diagram). Attach the AntGuard device between the support hook and hummingbird feeder. AntGuard begins to work immediately; all ant activity should stop within 24 hours. Under normal conditions AntGuard will give a full season of ant control.
