

Ants are attracted to food, debris and low-frequency electronic noises. The plastic in AntGuard<sup>TM</sup> is impregnated with an insecticide that kills and repels ants. AntGuard<sup>TM</sup> is designed to withstand rain, sun and the elements for 6 to 9 months of control.

Apply AntGuard™ to any pole, pipe, cable, rope, shaft or other outside surfaces where crawling insects can be deterred by interrupting routes of travel, such as:
